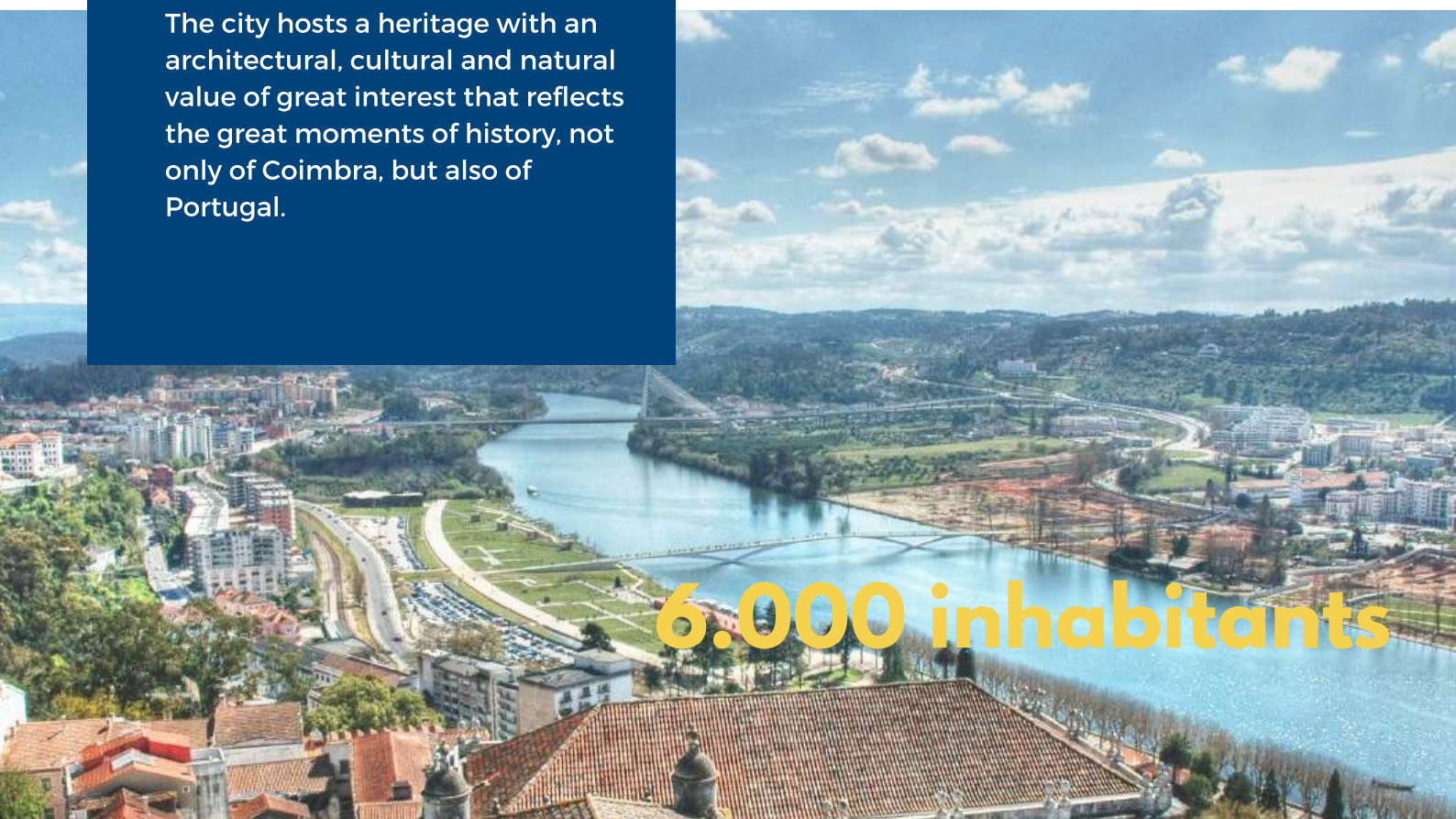
# THE CITY OF COIMBRA

The first muslim campaigns to conquer the Iberian Peninsula took place between 711 and 715 and Coimbra capitulated in 714.

The city was definitively reconquered by the Christians in 1064 by D. Fernando I, the Magno, and the government of the region was handed over to D. Sesnando, who recognized it economically and administratively.

D. Afonso Henriques, the first king of Portugal, settled with the court in Coimbra in 1112, becoming the seat of the kingdom.

The city hosts a heritage with an architectural, cultural and natural value of great interest that reflects the great moments of history, not only of Coimbra, but also of Portugal.

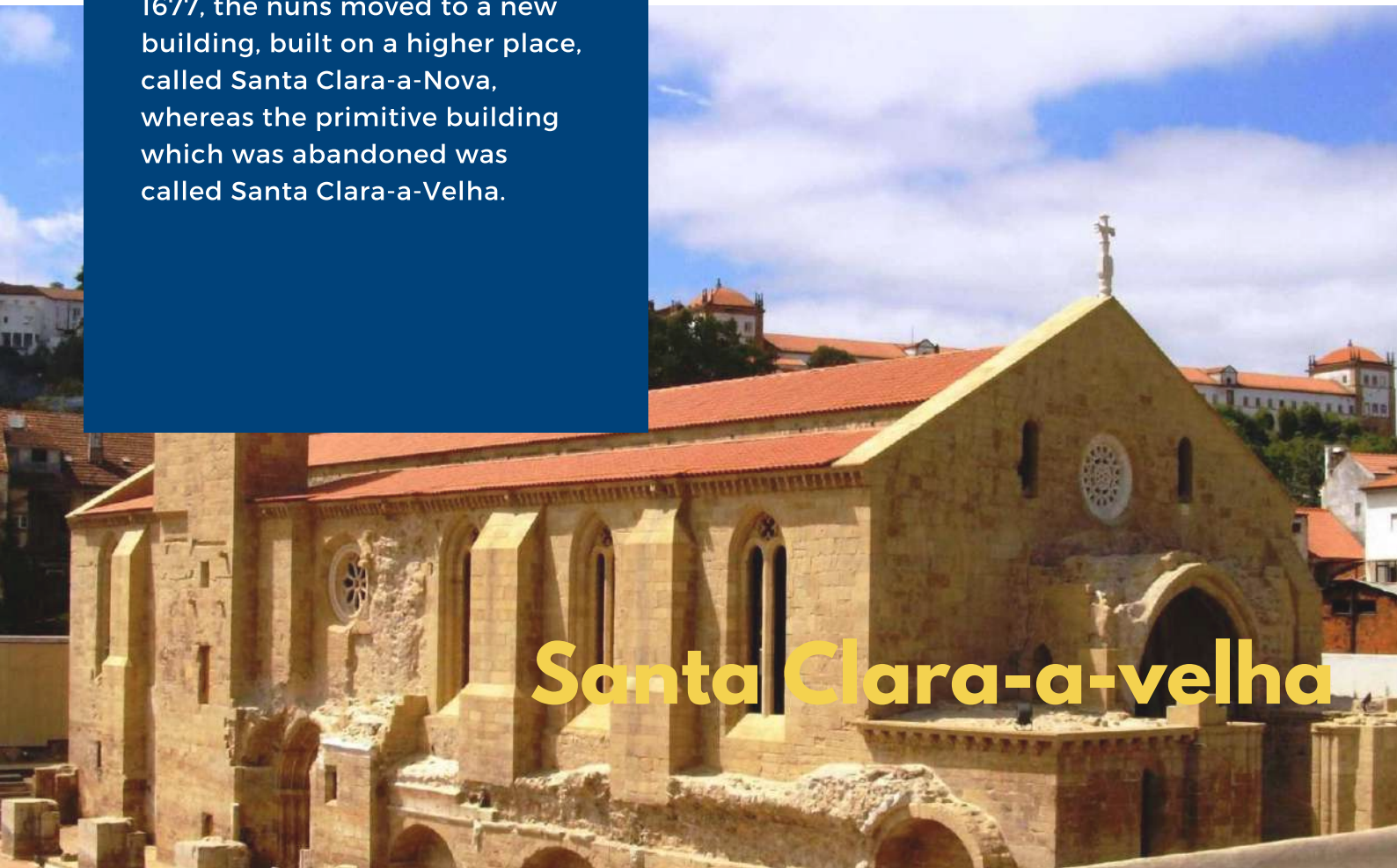
# SAINT CLARE MONASTERY

Founded in 1283, by D. Mor Dias, the Saint Clare Monastery was delivered to the Poor Clare Nuns shortly afterwards. D. Isabel of Aragão, known as Queen Saint Elisabeth, became interested in the convent and ordered the construction of new buildings in a gothic style, of which the cloister and the church are highlighted, sacred in 1330.

The Monastery was soon the scene of the floods caused by the Mondego river and had to be adapted with a new architectural build. Finally, in 1677, the nuns moved to a new building, built on a higher place, called Santa Clara-a-Nova, whereas the primitive building which was abandoned was called Santa Clara-a-Velha.

# NURSING SCHOOL OF COIMBRA

The Nursing School of Coimbra (in Portuguese, Escola Superior de Enfermagem de Coimbra - ESEnFC) is the result of the merge in 2006 of the Dr. Ângelo da Fonseca Nursing School (founded in 1881) and the Bissaya Barreto Nursing School (founded in 1971).

The school is the heir of the oldest nursing education in Portugal, being a national and international reference, for its quality and innovation, with recognized intervention in the health system and society, ESEnFC is a certified WHO Collaborating Center for Nursing Practice and Research, host of Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing's Phi Xi Chapter and recurrent member of the Latin American Association of Schools and Colleges of Nursing (ALADEFE). ESEnFC is a strong advocate for nursing research and professional education, hosting the Health Sciences Research Unit: Nursing (UICISA:E) and the Portuguese Association for Vascular Access (APoAVa).

The school is divided into three different campus: (A) Santo António dos Olivais; (B) São Martinho do Bispo (conference site); and (C) also in Santo António dos Olivais.

# UNIVERSITY OF COIMBRA

## «ALTA E SOFIA»

By signing "Scientiae thesaurus mirabilis", D. Dinis created the oldest university in the country and one of the oldest in the world. Dated from 1290, the document allows the creation of the General Study, which is recognized in the same year by Pope Nicholas IV. It starts to function in Lisbon, being transferred definitively to Coimbra in 1537, by order of King D. João III. It is in the Royal Palace of the Alcáçova, later Paço das Escolas, that all Faculties of the University of Coimbra are located - Theology, Canons, Laws and Medicine.

Nowadays, the University of Coimbra has eight Faculties (Literature, Law, Medicine, Science and Technology, Pharmacy, Economics, Psychology and Educational Sciences, Sports Sciences and Physical Education) and more than 22 thousand students.

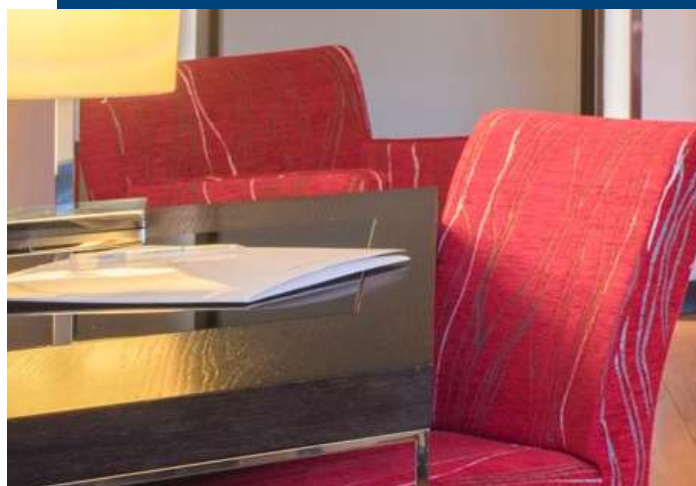

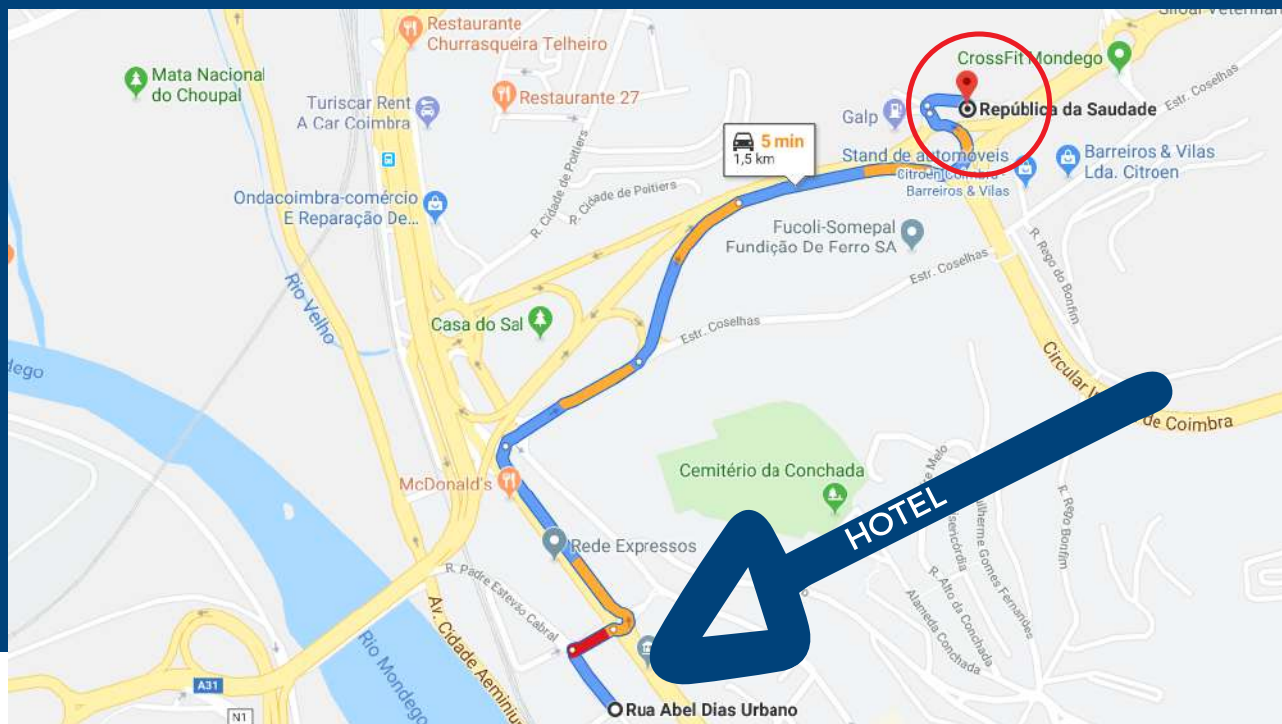

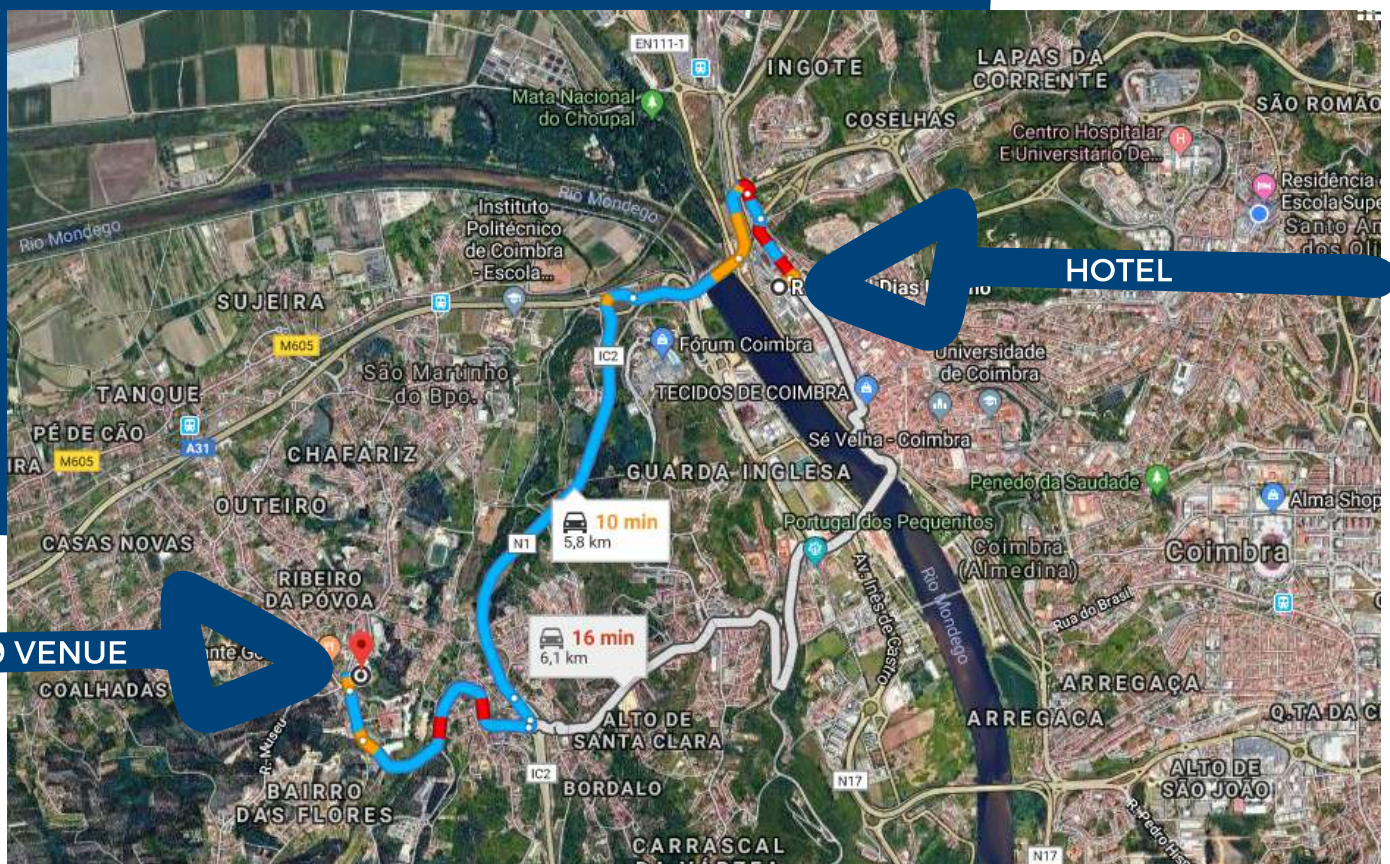

(gray)

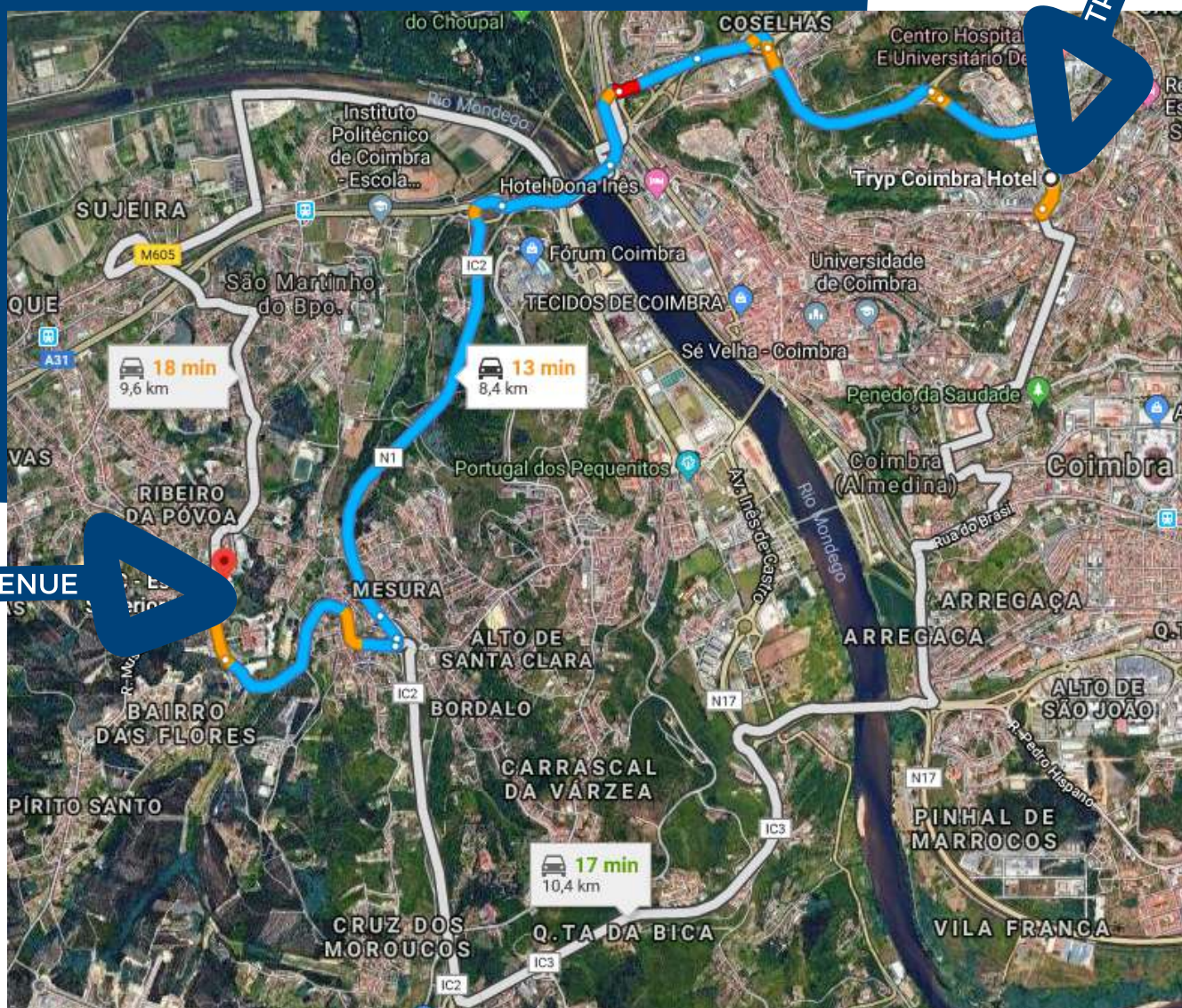
Rua Central - 16 min; 6,1 km.

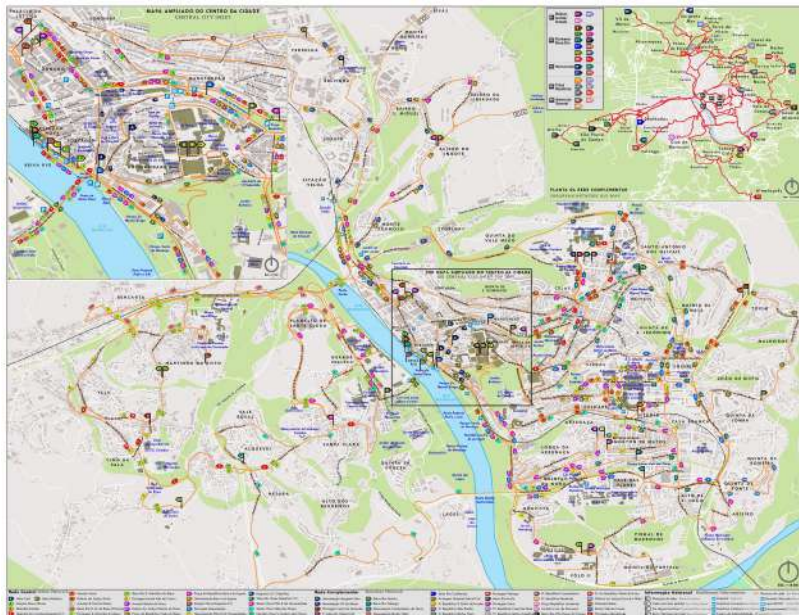

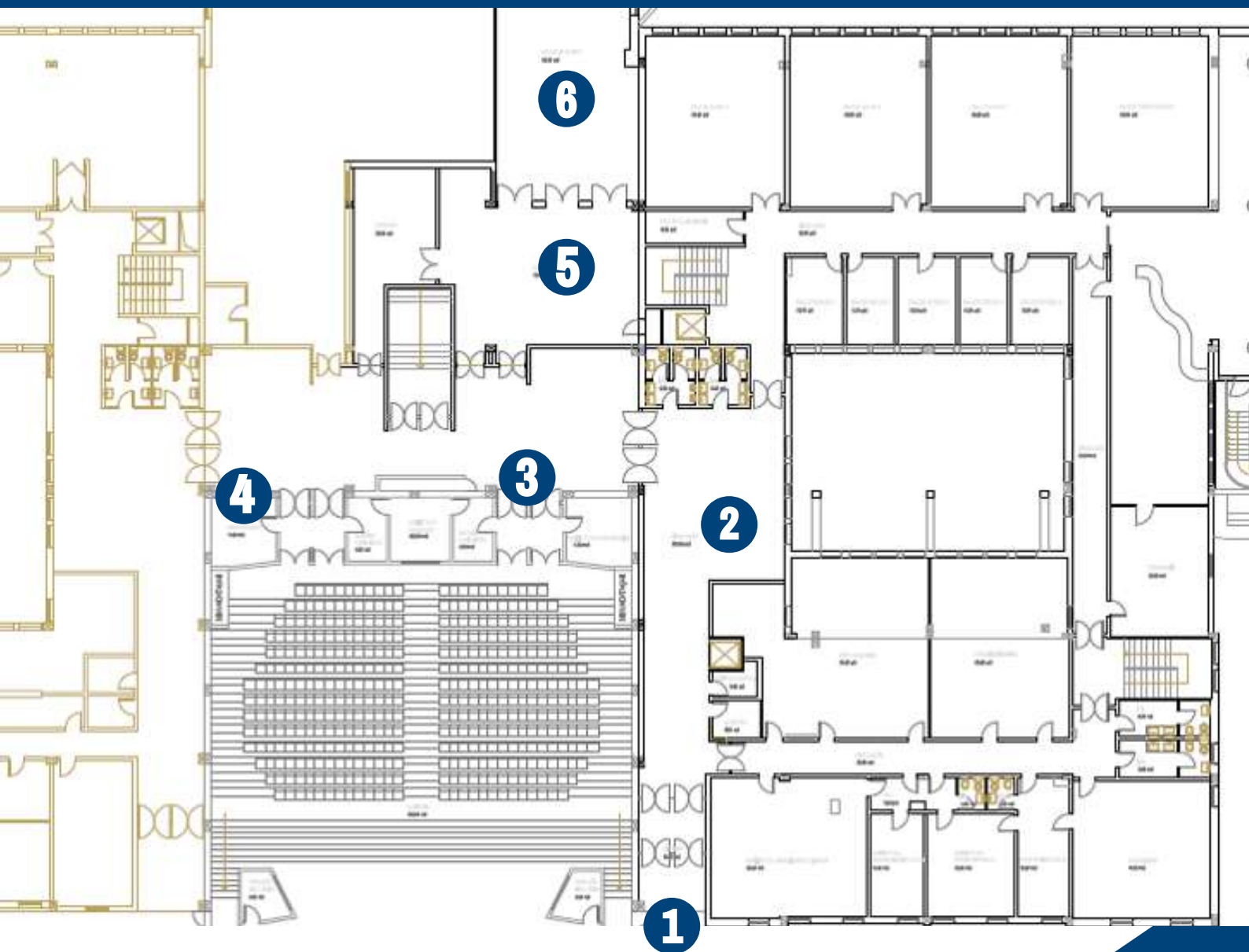
